The Prophet (PBUH) said about Shawwal's Fasting: "Whoever fasts six days after (Eid al-Fitr), has completed a year (of fasting)." The Prophet of Allah explained: "Allaah has made for each good deed ten like it, so a month is like fasting ten months, and fasting six days completes the year."

**Note:** First we must complete any missed days out of Ramadan's 30 days, then do the six of Shawwal
